Getting Started

with the **Marché du Film Online**

1

Create your Cinando account

(using the same email you registered with)

2

Connect to marchedufilm.online

(login with your Cinando account)

3

Choose your timezone

The Conference Schedule and Screening Schedule are shown in your local time zone, so it is important that you select the right time zone.

MARCHÉ DU FILM ONLINE

For the best online experience, we recommend using a computer (Mac or PC) with the **latest version of Windows** or **macOS**. While our platform is accessible on tablets, it's not fully optimized for mobile devices.

Please make sure you're using the **latest version** of **Google Chrome**, **Firefox**, or **Safari**.

And don't forget — a stable internet connection is key! For the best streaming quality, we suggest using a wired connection whenever possible.



Attending **Online Screenings**

Watch exclusive **world premieres** in **your local time zone!**

To access online screenings and watch a film, simply click on the **Screenings** tab in the main menu.

A film can be started within 120 minutes of the official screening start time.

No pre-registration is required to view a screening. However, some screenings are reserved for **specific participants** (e.g. Sales Agents only). **If you do not meet the criteria, you may not be able to access it.**

(NB: For certain screenings, you may have the option to request an invitation directly from the sales agent.)

DID YOU KNOW?

Missed a screening during Cannes? Catch up on market screenings — available for streaming on Cinando after the Marché du Film event!

Access to screenings is granted based on specific criteria.

The different access types are

Buyers

F

Festival Programmers

S

Sales Agents

EC

Europa Cinema

P

Press

If you do not meet the criteria, you may request an invitation from the sales agent.



Livestreaming **Conferences** & Other **Events**

DID YOU KNOW?

Most of our conferences will be available on replay after the event via the Marché du Film's **YouTube** channel.

You can access the conferences on the **Marché du Film Online** through your **Talque web agenda** — just click on the **Conferences** tab in the main menu.

Please note that you'll need to log in to the Talque app the first time you access the platform.

The majority of events are scheduled **between 9:00 and 20:00** (UTC+2) and will be **displayed in your local time zone**.

You'll be redirected to their contact page, where you can find their preferred method of communication — whether it's **phone**, **email**, **chat**, or another option.

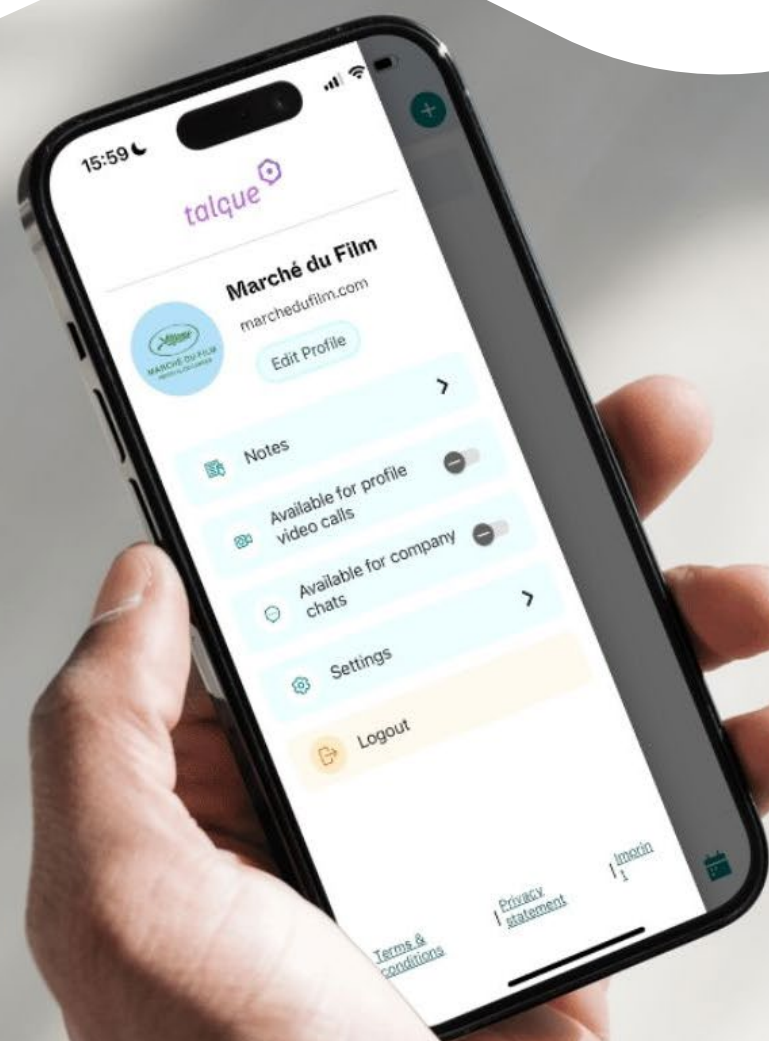

The Marché du Film app (powered by Talque) is your essential companion for navigating the Marché du Film Online. With everything you need right at your fingertips, you can easily connect with market participants, explore online screenings and exhibitors, and view the full event schedule.

You can access it via the mobile app or desktop (Chrome or Firefox) — whichever works best for you. If you're using the mobile app, be sure to install the latest version for the best experience!

- **iOS 12.5** or higher
 - **Android 8** or higher
- The Talque app also works in the browser on most current mobile platforms.*

SUPPORTED VERSIONS FOR THE TALQUE DESKTOP

- **Google Chrome and MS Edge Chromium**
(latest version recommended)
- **Firefox and Safari**
(latest versions)

Talque is not supported on Internet Explorer. We do not recommend using Firefox for group video calls, as it can significantly affect video quality for all participants.

Talque also requires access to several internet resources.
